

# **HOW TO EXPOSE PLASTIC AND CANS?**

In the yellow bags supplied, or in semi-transparent bags of approximately 120 liters purchased independently.



#### WHAT IF CONTAINERS ARE STOLEN O DAMAGED?

It is necessary to complete a self-certification which can be downloaded from the website <a href="https://www.clarambiente.it/contatti/modulistica/">www.clarambiente.it/contatti/modulistica/</a> (Dichiarazione sostitutiva di atto di notorietà), and submit it to the management service when requesting for the replacement of the container.

# WHERE AND WHEN TO RETURN CONTAINERS?

If you move house and terminate the utility, the containers must be returned to the CLARA delivery point in PortoInforma, piazza G. Verdi 22, on Tuesdays, from 9am to 12pm.

In the green road bells found in the streets of the town.

In the yellow-colored Humana containers found in some streets of the town.

# Delivery of rigid containers for waste collection and microchipping of those already in use

Dear user,

We are delivering **new rigid containers for waste collection.** 

In particular, we are delivering:

- a gray bin, for the collection of non-recyclable waste;
- a wheeled bin with a blue lid, for the collection of paper and cardboard;
- a wheeled bin with a green lid, for the collection of any grass clippings and branches.
- **We are also microchipping the organic waste bin** already in use.

The new containers must be used immediately to replace the bags. As soon as the container distribution phase is completed, the bags will no longer be collected (except for those for plastic and cans), and any waste exposed outside the bins will not be collected either.



We take this opportunity to remind you that **registration** with the waste management service is mandatory. If you are not yet in compliance, please contact the toll-free number 800-881133, and make an appointment to register for the service.

On the back of this sheet, you will find other important information for the correct use of the containers; please read it carefully.

#### ARE DOOR-TO-DOOR COLLECTION CONTAINERS PAYABLE?

**NO**, they are granted on loan for free use, and are to be used only for waste disposal. Possession of new containers does not entail any change in the rate calculation system.



#### WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTAINERS?

The user, who must keep them clean and disinfected.

#### WHEN SHOULD CONTAINERS BE EXPOSED TO BE EMPTIED?



Only at the times and days indicated in the calendar. Users are also required to collect containers once emptied. It is forbidden to expose containers on days or times other than those scheduled: violators may be sanctioned.

# **WHAT IF A CONTAINER IS NOT EMPTIED?**

Waste collection can take place both in the morning and in the afternoon. If the exposed container is not emptied on the day scheduled by the calendar, from the following day the user can report it to the toll-free number 800-881133.

### **HOW TO EXPOSE NON-RECYCLABLE AND ORGANIC WASTE CONTAINERS?**

It is prohibited to expose containers with lids raised and/or with additional waste bags exposed next to or on top of the containers. Operators will collect only waste that is

correctly placed inside the closed container, and not loose.



#### **HOW TO EXPOSE CLIPPINGS AND PRUNINGS?**

Grass clippings and vegetable waste should be placed loose inside the green bin. For each collection round, it is also possible to expose up to 4 bundles outside the bin. Alternatively, they can be disposed of to the Collection Centre in via Montecuccoli (see <a href="https://www.clarambiente.it">www.clarambiente.it</a> for

opening days and times).

#### **HOW TO EXPOSE PAPER AND CARDBOARD?**

In the 120-liter blue wheeled bins. The use of this container is not mandatory: you can continue to expose paper and cardboard in boxes, cartons, or disposable paper bags. However, it will no longer be possible to use other returnable containers (wooden or plastic boxes, buckets, basins, etc.).
